CHAPTER 5

TOWN OF BURNS HARBOR, INDIANA

GARBAGE & REFUSE

Sec. 5-1. GARBAGE REGULATIONS.

- A. It shall be the duty of every person who is the owner or occupant of any premises within the corporate limits *of the Town of Burns Harbor, Indiana to use the size and style of garbage container provided or authorized by the Town of Burns Harbor for garbage or refuse to be collected by or on behalf of the Town.*
- B. Said garbage receptacles shall be placed within the lot lines at the edge of the roadway, and in the location deemed best for efficient pick-up upon those days so designated. Garbage receptacles, however, shall be placed outside of yard fences. All receptacles shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition. The containers must have lids which fit tightly and all containers must be kept closed at all times.
- C. Garbage shall be placed in paper or plastic bags or shall be wrapped in paper or plastic and then placed in appropriate containers.
- D. All refuse collected from any residence or business on each regular pick-up in excess of that which is contained in *the containers authorized by the Town of Burns Harbor* shall be collected at the expense of the occupants of said residence *or business.*
- E. All owners or occupants shall have a sufficient number of garbage and trash receptacles to accommodate one week's refuse accumulation.
- F. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than ten (\$10.00) dollars and each day any provision of this ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate and distinct violation.
- G. Newspapers and magazines shall be tied in bundles with cord strong enough to bear the weight of the bundle it contains.
